WHEREAS, these individuals, known as law enforcement officers, are the guardians of life and property, defenders of the innocent, warriors in the battle against crime, and are dedicated to the preservation of life and property; and

WHEREAS, it is important that our people know and understand the problems, duties, and responsibilities of their police departments and the necessity for cooperating with them in maintaining law and order; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that we express our gratitude for the dedicated service and courageous deeds of law enforcement officers and for the contributions they have made to the security and well-being of all our people; and

WHEREAS, we desire to honor the service, valor and dedication of these law enforcement officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved, that in conjunction with Law Enforcement Memorial Week, May 13-19, 2019, the Rome City Commission and Floyd County Board of Commissioners hereby designate May 17, 2019 as Peace Officers Memorial Day. We honor those peace officers who, through their courageous deeds, have lost their lives or have become disabled in the performance of duty.


